The following recycling material is what we will collect and how it must be prepared. This list will changed if the recycling center changes the recycling material they will accept. We will modify our recycling collection.



Newspapers

Do not bundle or tie. Keep separate from magazines and mixed paper and keep dry. Inserts can remain.



Glass Bottles and Jars

Separate glass bottles and jars by color; clear, brown and green. Food and beverage containers only. Windows, light bulbs, windshields and cookware are all made of a different type of glass and are not accepted. Remove all lids and rings and rinse well. Labels can remain.



Mixed Paper

Includes office paper, junk mail, glossy paper, colored paper, envelopes, coupons, phone books, etc. Separate from magazines and newspapers, keep dry. Bag shredded paper.



Steel or "Bimetal" Cans

Rinse cans well and secure the lid inside. Labels can remain.



Magazines & Catalogs

Corrugated Cardboard

Separate magazines and catalogs from other paper and keep dry. Do not bundle or tie.

Plastics Bottles & Containers

Include soda and water bottles, milk jugs, laundry jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt containers, butter tubs and berry containers. Rinse well, labels and caps can remain.



Crushing plastic containers helps save space and it is acceptable to bag plastics for curbside pickup.

Aluminum Cans & Foil
